Installation Instructions

System Requirements

A Microsoft Windows 2000, XP, VISTA, or Windows 7 operating system is required to run the 3D SSPP program.

Installation

Note: If the computer system is Windows, then you must be logged in as an administrator to install software. If help is needed, contact your computer support staff person.

The following instructions assume that you are installing the software onto a local workstation (not a network). Network installation requires a special license.

Installation from a CD

If the software has been obtained on a CD, then insert the CD into the CD drive. If your computer has auto run enabled, the setup program should automatically start. If it doesn't, navigate through Windows to the CD and find the setup file named similar to **3DSSPP_Installer.msi**. Double-click on the file and follow the on-screen installation instructions.

Installation from a Downloaded File

If the software has been downloaded, locate the setup file with the name similar to **3DSSPP_Installer.msi** on the computer (desktop, hard drive, or where ever it was saved). Verify that the size downloaded file is the same as that listed on the 3DSSPP website. If it is not, your download may be incomplete or corrupted and the file should be re-downloaded before installation is attempted. Once the file has been successfully downloaded and located, double-click on it and follow the on-screen installation instructions.

Running the Program

If the “Create a Desktop Icon” option was selected during install, double click the 3DSSPP icon on your desktop. If this option was not selected, go to the Start Menu, choose Programs, and select **3DSSPP 6.X.X**. Alternatively you can find the program, 3DSSPP.exe, in C:\ProgramFiles\University of Michigan\3DSSPP if the default location was selected during the installation.

Entering Licensed To Name and Registration Number

The first time the program is started, or if a registration number has not been previously entered, the registration dialog will appear. Enter the license to name and registration number, and then select the OK button. To operate the program in Demonstration Mode, click the “Cancel” button.

Evaluation Period

The program will run and will be completely functional for a period of 14 days after installation. After 14 day the program must be licensed and a licensed to name and registration code must be purchased as described above.

Introductory Screen

Before the data entry windows appear, a screens of general information is displayed, which should be read carefully. Press the ENTER key or click on the OK button to continue.
